In the Middle of a Storm

“When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing.” -John 6:16-18

When have you felt alone in a storm?

“When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were terrified. But he said to them, ‘It is I; do not be afraid.’ Then they wanted to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the land toward which they were going.” -John 6:19-21

Jesus shows us His power in the middle of our storms.

Jesus has the power to stand above and overcome any fear, challenge, storm, barrier, and sweeping change we face.

“Peter answered him, ‘Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.’ He said, ‘Come.’ So Peter got out of the boat, started walking on the water, and came toward Jesus.” -Matthew 14:28-29
