DARE 2 – Dream Killers

Who or what arrests and engages my heart?

Because God-sized dreams are challenging, there are plenty of dream killers that can grab hold of our hearts and hold us back from pursuing our dreams.

In Numbers 13 we see three dream killers that the Israelites faced and that we face:

- Fear
- Insecurity
- Discouragement

Dream killers cause us to stay where we are. (“Someday I’m going to....”)

Even worse, dream killers draw us back to where we’ve been. (“Let’s go back to Egypt.”)

God wants us to overcome every dream killer that gets in our way.

In order to do that - Never fight dream killers alone.

Connect with God and connect with each other.
